

Suggestions for a trip to Cern Geneva

- Two nights and two full days are sufficient. I would suggest that you depart Thursday night and return Saturday Night, if you stay in Geneva on Sunday most of the shops and attractions are closed.
- We flew from Luton to Geneva with Easy jet
- Remember to pick up the temporary transport card before you leave the arrivals area. The machines are just as you leave the baggage area and go through customs When you arrive at your accommodation you will be given a permanent travel card. This allows free travel on all transport in Geneva
- We stayed in the YHA in Geneva

Travel from the Airport to the YHA

Take the train (go down the escalator to the platform) or the number 5 bus to Corvavin, then get the tram 15 to Nations and travel 2 stops to Butin. Walk down the hill take the second road on the left to Rue Rothschild The YHA is on the left.

Travel from the YHA to Cern

Take the tram 15 back to Corvavin, then get the tram 14 to Cern the stop for the tram to Cern is around the corner. Get of the tram, walk to the left, and the tram stop is on the first road on the right under a bridge. You would be advised to take you passports as some parts of Cern are in France.

Regulation of Youth Hostel Geneva

I have read and accepted the terms and conditions listed below:

- 1. The group leader(s) must be the obligation to ensure the smooth running of stay and to intervene in case of problems. They will be awakened at any time during night if their group has discipline problems.**
- 2. In case of major problems or if the group is out of control and /or the situation requires police intervention any cost and damages of the facilities will be charged to the group.**
- 3. Smoking and drinking is strictly forbidden in all rooms.**
- 4. Picnicking and cooking is not allowed in all rooms.**
- 5. It is completely forbidden to make noise from 10 pm in buildings, in surrounding streets and slamming locker's room lockers because many of our travellers have early flights.**
- 6. You are not allowed to touch the smoke sensors installed in the rooms. In case of fire fighters intervention, additional costs will be charged to the group.**

Geneva Transport Card

Public transport is free for tourists in Geneva (as far as CERN). On arrival at the airport, we will collect our free tickets from the machines for transfer to the hostel. Make sure you keep hold of your airline boarding card/ticket as proof that you flew in that day. At the hostel we will be given our free transport cards for travel within the city during our stay.

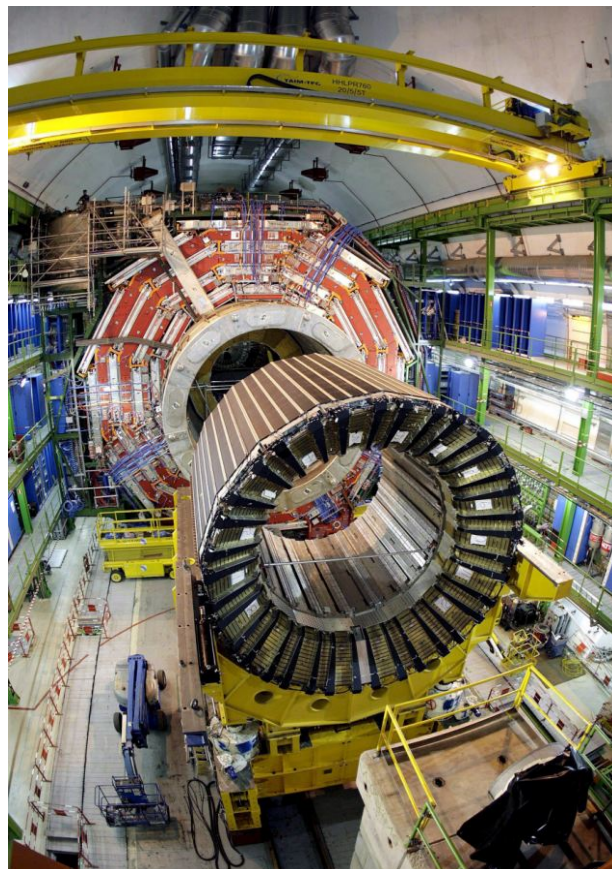
