TEACH PHYSICS 2024

The Teach Physics internship programme provides 4-5 week placements in school science departments. Students gain an intensive experience of teaching physics and broader school life, as well as developing transferable skills for other careers.



Benefits for interns include:

- an intensive experience, both of teaching physics, and of broader school life
- support from experienced mentors as well as the Trust
- improved understanding of different presentation styles, through observations and involvement in lessons as well as extra-curricular activities
- augmented reflective practice through writing a report
- opportunities to develop resources and build strong communication skills
- increased confidence and knowledge
- a £300 weekly education grant for the duration of the placement

You will:

- observe and assist with all aspects of teaching
- plan and deliver your own lessons
- give a presentation/lead a workshop on applying to university
- run/assist with extra-curricular clubs and activities
- work with pupils with SEN and/or on the G&T register
- submit a reflective report
